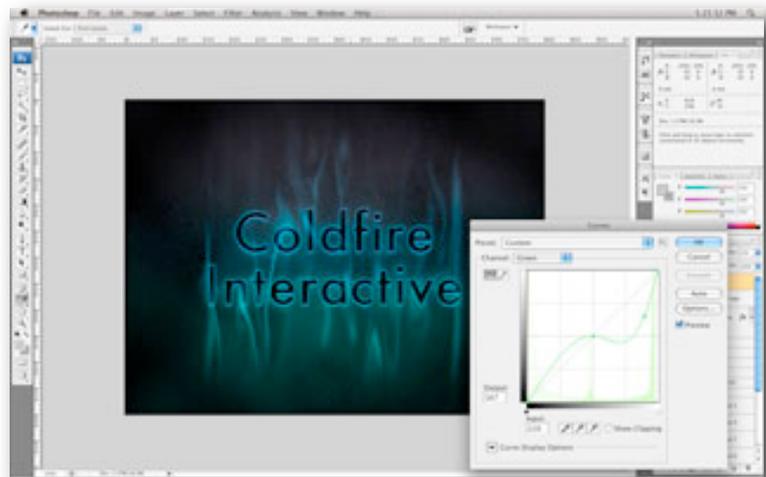


Adobe Photoshop

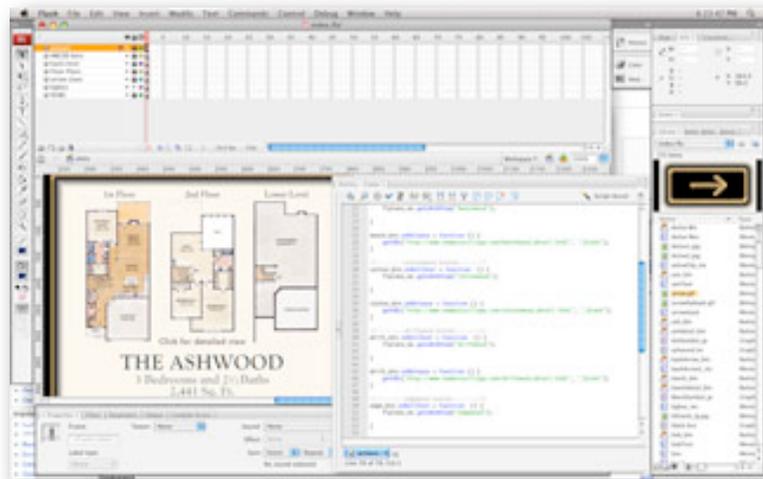

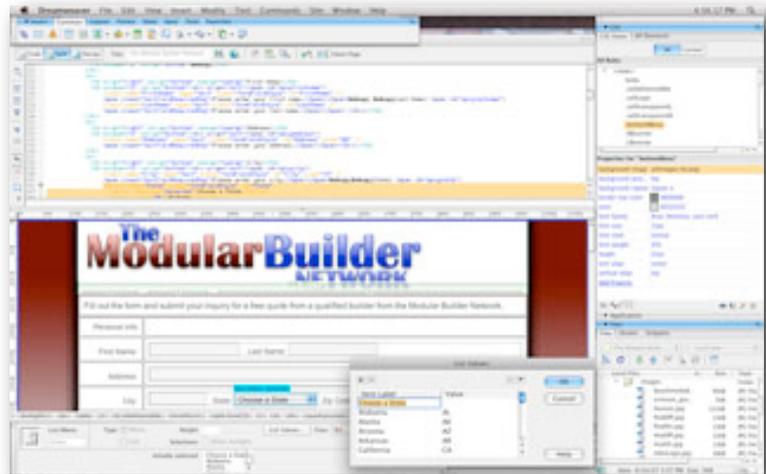


Adobe Dreamweaver

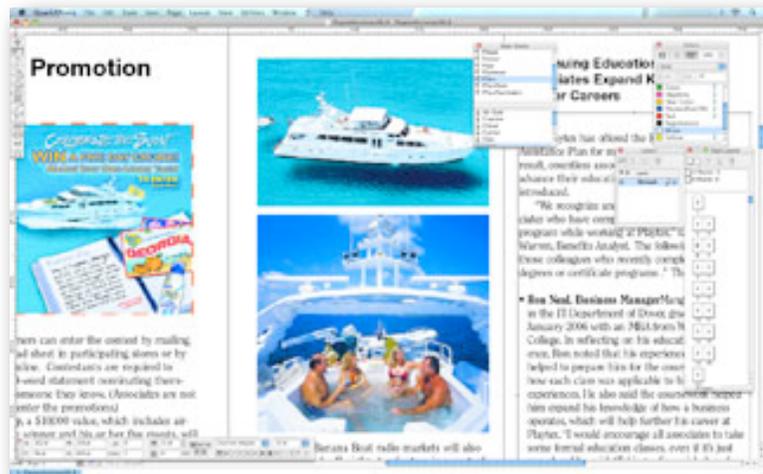


Quark XPress
